

TRAVELLING BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

We are delighted to have moved into our new premises at The Gatehouse, 24 Southend Road in Beckenham. In order to make your journey to the clinic as easy as possible, please read the following instructions carefully.

The map below shows the location of the clinic, represented by the red pin. Entry to the building is via the grey door which faces onto Beckenham Place Park road.





Please be mindful that the junction outside the clinic is very busy to cross. There are street crossings opposite Waitrose & Partners and further down Foxgrove Road.

Travelling by train

The nearest train stations are [Beckenham Junction](#), [Beckenham Hill](#), [Ravensbourne](#) and [New Beckenham](#) (please see map on next page). All of these stations are served by National Rail trains. The location of the stations is shown on the map by the purple train markers and the clinic is represented by the red pin. The following page shows the walking distance to each station and the relevant timetables.



We recommend Beckenham Junction as it is the nearest train station. The fastest walking route from each station is shown as a blue dotted line above.

[Beckenham Junction](#) station is a 6 minute (0.2 miles) walk away. It is served by trains to Victoria, Orpington and London Bridge. The timetable for these services can be found [here](#).

New Beckenham station is a 13 minute (0.5 miles) walk away and is served by trains to Hayes and London Charing Cross. The timetable for these services can be found [here](#).

Beckenham Hill station is a 21 minute (0.9 miles) walk away and is served by trains to Sevenoaks, Welwyn Garden City and Kentish Town. **Ravensbourne station** is a 19 minute (0.8 miles) walk away and is served by the same services. Travelling by tram

Beckenham Junction station also has a tram stop with trams travelling to Croydon and Wimbledon. This tram stop is a 6 minute walk (0.3 miles) from the clinic, shown on the map below. The London tram map from tfl.gov.uk is also shown below. The timetable for trams can be found [here](#).
